

Introductions to the Archives

This weekend you should start considering what archive you are interested in using for your Humanities Inquiry.

- You should also spend some time on the website for each archive that seems interesting to you. Look over the skill module associated with that library. The PCL Map Room does not have an associated skill module).
- Then please, by Monday, email the associated UGTA to sign up to attend a tour offered over the course of next week. Dates and times of the tours are listed on the next page. You are not required to take a tour, but it will help introduce you to that facility. It will also likely help you to complete the skill module attached to that archive.
- When you have chosen an archive for your Inquiry please make contact with the UGTA associated with that library! In most cases you will just need to send an email to let them know you are working that library and use them as a resource if you need help.

IF YOU CHOOSE THE HRC: You will have to sign up for slots to use the Reading Room. Please do not visit the Reading Room without signing up for a slot!!! You will be able to sign up for multiple days to complete your research, but DO NOT PROCRASTINATE because only four students will be allowed to use the reading room each day. If you put it off and the days are full you are out of luck. They are a busy research library and have granted us permission to use their resources for this course based on our willingness to limit the number of students using it at one time.
