How to request a regrade of your Quest quiz or exam

A Good Reason to Request a Regrade: Occasionally you will look at your grades from a quiz or exam and say, "that can't possibly be right." Usually this is because you got a zero or no test score was recorded. The reason for this is that

YOU MESSED UP

That's okay, we will fix it if you let us know.

A Bad Reason to Request a Regrade: Occasionally you will look at your grades from a quiz or exam and say, "that can't possibly be right" when you received a 55 instead of a 92. You will want to blame the scantron, or the pencil you were using, or the computer that did the grading. Guess what

YOU DIDN"T MESS UP

At least not on the scantron. Actually where you messed up is thinking you knew the material when you didn't. Still, you can request a regrade and even though in the history of the world, the computer has never messed up in grading a scantron, we will humor you and rescan.

To request a regrade, send an e-mail to Travis at <u>ubertravis@gmail.com</u> that does the following:

- 1. Includes the words "Regrade Request Laude" in the subject heading.
- 2. Provides adequate information in the body of the e-mail including the unique number of the course, your name, eid, the exact assignment (e.g. make up exam 1 if it was the first make up exam), version number and a clear concise summary of the concern.

Travis will get back to you pronto.

Deadline for Regrades. There will be a two-week limit with respect to regrades on quizzes. So if you do not submit a regrade request to Travis by e-mail within two weeks of the quiz date, you get the grade that is recorded. With exams we will give you a little more slack, but try to be prompt with your regrade requests.
